ABOUT YARP (Young Adult Reentry Partnership)

YARP offers 2 pathways to success: training coupled with work experience and education. YARP offers on-the-job, industry-recognized trainings in managing hazardous materials, operating powered industrial trucks, and directing activities in a warehouse. Through YARP, you can complete your High School Equivalency during the workday. If you are ready to pursue a technical certificate or associate degree, YARP can help you enroll in Ivy Tech Community College. You may be surprised how many credits you could be awarded for prior learning, including completing some of the training programs offered through YARP.

WORK FOR PAY

You will work, first, at RecycleForce. The job pays \$15 per hour for about 4 months. You will learn to take things apart using hand tools. You will also work on large machines in the warehouse – shredders, balers, and machines that separate metal and plastic.

TRAINING

Before starting work at RecycleForce, you will train on warehouse safety. As you work, you will have the opportunity to be trained in other skills employers value:

- Driving a forklift
- Safe handling of dangerous items (HAZWOPER 40)
- Construction safety (OSHA 10)
 Safe handling of dangerous gases
- in appliances (EPA 608)
- Moving products in a warehouse (Certified Logistics Associate)

MENTORING

Mentoring is a way for a person with more knowledge or experience to coach or guide someone with less knowledge and experience. This can be done one-on-one or in a group. Keys2Work/RecycleForce offers this service to those who want it. Many staff at RecycleForce are trained as mentors, and most of them started right where you are – leaving jail or prison and enrolling in RecycleForce training and job programs.
